The Sermon Outline by Pastor Willie White, Jr.

March 14, 2021

RECYCLE ME!!!

Mark 5:15-34; verse 34 = And he said unto her, Daughter, thy faith hath made thee whole, go in peace, and be whole of thy plague.

My SON-KISSED Brothers and Sisters, in today's society, most of us have two trash cans that the city has provided for us. One trash can is green and the other trash can is blue. The green trash can is used for food items, leftover food that must be thrown away. The blue trash can is used for recycling items, like paper, plastic, glass, and cans. We have two trash cans, one for trash and the other for recycling. I was very inquisitive this week. I asked myself the question: "How are the people able to recycle these items?" I did my homework and what I discovered blew my mind. The items in the recycling trash can are taken to the recycling center, where fire is used to break down the core components of the paper--plastic, glass, and cans--in order to reshape them into something brand new. What I learned in my research about recycling paper, plastic, glass and cans is that they can't be reshaped until they are put under enough heat, that they can be stripped of all the external; and only the inner essentials are left. Then the materials can be remade.

Here in our text this morning we have a certain woman, who was put into the fire and she was remade. **RECYCLE ME!!!**

1: GOALS (Aims, Objectives, Purpose). Verses 25-28: God's goals should be our goals. Our most important goal should be getting to know Jesus better. **RECYCLE ME!!!**

2: GOSSIP (Deception, Lies, Rumors). Verses 29-33: Gossip breaks down relationships. Gossip is often more harmful and lasting than physical wounds. Gossip wastes valuable time. **RECYCLE ME!!!**

3: GIVING UP (Abandon, Quit, Surrender). Verse 34: Giving up often causes us to miss the best God has to offer. God's absolute sovereignty is one reason to never give up. **RECYCLE ME!!!**
