

Early detection saves lives

According to the CDC, women with disabilities are less likely to undergo breast cancer screening due to the inaccessibility of radiology and mammography equipment.

Women using wheelchairs and other mobility equipment may be unable to position themselves close enough to screening equipment as needed to get a clear exam.



Signs of a Problem

If you notice any of these symptoms during your breast selfexam, call your doctor:


- A lump
- Swelling
- Skin irritationDimpling
- Pain
- Nipple retraction (nipple turns in)
- Redness of nipple or breast skin
- Scaly nipple or breast skin
- Nipple discharge


Any lump should be checked right away. Tests may be needed. In some cases, a *biopsy* may be done to look at the tissue.











