### MEDICAL ADVICE EVERY MAN SHOULD FOLLOW



#### Take care of your mental health

Talk to your doctor or a therapist about overwhelming feelings like anxiety or depression. Try to reduce stress.



#### Find a (good) doctor

#### Eat clean

2 - 3 cups of vegetables and 1 - 2 cups of fruit every day. Choose lean protein like fish and chicken.



#### Watch your weight

Have your body fat measured and aim to have less than 20% body fat.

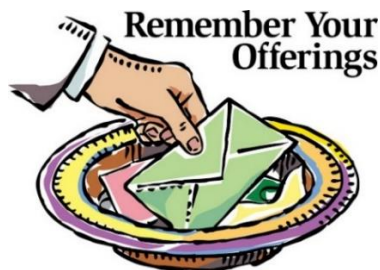
