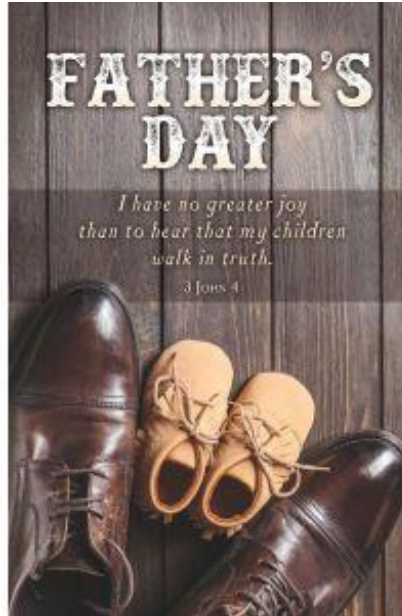

Remember. Reflect. Refocus.

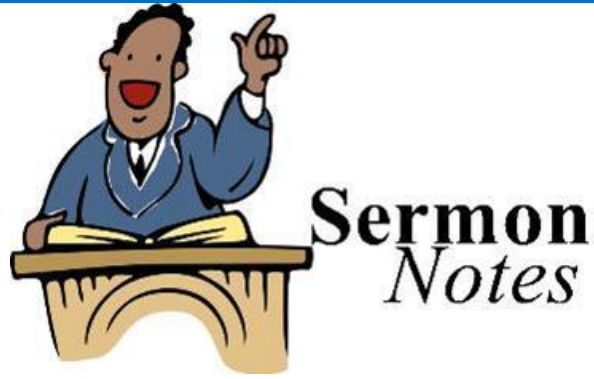

Quitting smoking has immediate and long-term benefits. It improves your health and lowers your risk of heart disease, cancer, lung disease, and other smoking related illnesses.

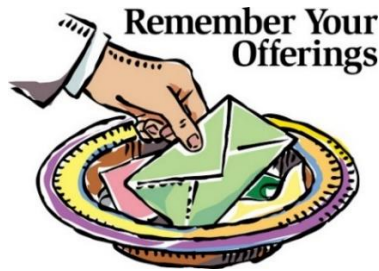
Eat to THRIVE

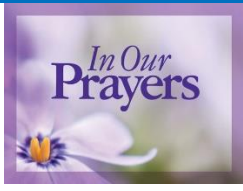
