Men's Health Awareness

Men's Health Awareness Month during June is an opportunity to encourage Black men to take more proactive steps towards better health.

According to health experts, it is particularly important for Black men to be aware of symptoms that often are overlooked, yet may indicate serious illness. These include:

- Unexplained Weight Changes could mean problems with the thyroid or heart.
- Trouble Urinating might point to prostate cancer.
- Unexplained Bruising could indicate a blood disorder.
- · Yellow Eyes may signify liver problems.
- Sleep Problems, either too much or not enough, can indicate depression or heart issues.

Too often, Black men delay visiting a doctor until an emergency. When symptoms are present, prompt medical advice is essential to ensure early detection and treatment..
