I saw a post on Facebook today in which the author described this month as “FebYOUary”. They went on to state that this is a good time to invest in and pour into yourself. I wholeheartedly agree! If we are honest most of us spend so much time and energy doing for and seeing about others. On our jobs, in the home, even at the church you can find those who constantly, consistently give, give give. I propose today that while caring for, giving to, and pouring into others is admirable and noteworthy, it should not come at the expense of losing yourself. If you don't get anything else from this article, remember this “**Self-care is NOT selfish**”. Self-care is at the heart of self-love.

It is often said that you cannot pour from an empty cup- so today determine to make time to be refreshed, revived, and refueled. In Mark 12: 30-31 Jesus says, “And you must love the LORD your God with all your heart, all your soul, all your mind, and all your strength. ³¹ The second is equally important: ‘Love your neighbor as yourself.’ No other commandment is greater than these.” **No other commandment is GREATER than these.** This leads me to question; how can one love their neighbor if they don't first love themselves? The answer is simple, you can't! You cannot truly love anyone else if you do not love yourself.

Self-love is multi-faceted. Self-love means valuing oneself, knowing your worth, prioritizing and caring for your own health and well-being. Self-love looks like intentionally setting time aside to do things that are nurturing and benefitting to you. Self-love is scheduling a massage, or day at the spa. Self-love looks like taking a warm bath instead of a quick shower, making time to read a book, or do a craft that you've been wanting to do. Self-love is putting the phone on DND (do not disturb) so that you can have an uninterrupted nap, TV, or prayer time. Self-love is saying “NO” when you simply cannot add anything else to your already busy schedule and not feeling guilty about it. Self-love is scheduling that appointment with your physician- because your best self is your healthy self. Self-love is booking that trip, saving up for that next adventure, and investing in yourself.

Self-love also means being gentle with yourself- and giving yourself some grace. It's okay that you didn't get everything done on your lengthy to do list. It's ok that the laundry is piling up, and the inside of your car temporarily looks a mess. It's ok to have a bad day, a late day, an “ I don't feel like adult-ing today ” day. 5 FACTS ABOUT THE HUMAN HEART THAT WILL AMAZE YOU


1. It supplies blood to every cell apart from the cornea.
