What does it mean to Worship? Worship is when an individual acknowledges and celebrates God’s power and perfections with love and gratitude. True worship of the Father is when we love Him with all our heart, soul, mind, and strength. Many individuals think that worship only comes in the form of singing. However, we can worship God by reading scriptures, listening to worship music, enjoying the creations, serving within the



community/ church, praise dancing, singing and more.

I remember the first time I was introduced to praise dance, what a glorious time we had in San Antonio, Texas. One of the dancers Mrs. Bedell came to me and said you should join the Dance Ministry Team. At that moment I was unaware that the Father was calling me to minister through dance; therefore, I declined that offer and continued my other roles within the church. Being a Service Member, we move often, soon as we arrived at our next duty station, there was another offer for me to join a Praise Dance Team.
