fantastic!**

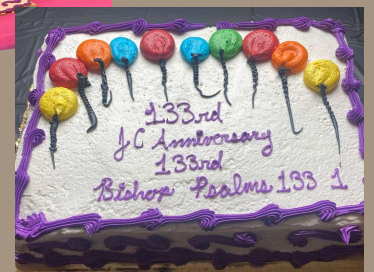

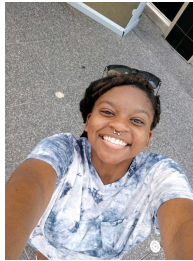
