



Born: February 4, 1913 Died: October 24, 2005



Rosa Parks became a civil rights activist when she refused to give up her seat on a bus to a white passenger. Her brave actions started the Montgomery Bus Boycott and other efforts to end segregation.

"memories of our lives, of our works and our deeds will continue in others." — Rosa Parks Rosa eventually moved from Montgomery, Alabama to Detroit, Michigan, where she spent the rest of her life fighting for equal rights for all people

On December 1, 1955, the driver of the Cleveland Ave. bus in Montgomery, Alabama demanded that Rosa Parks give up her seat and stand on the bus so that a white man could sit down. She refused, because she was tired of being bullied for being an African American woman. The driver called the police, and she was arrested. Her actions started the Montgomery Bus Boycott and other civil rights movements. The boycott ended on December 20, 1956, when the city had no choice but to lift the enforcement of segregation on city busses.
