Chaplain (Lieutenant Colonel-P) Kyle A. Taylor

USAACE Senior Command Chaplain

Chaplain (LTC-P) Kyle A. Taylor is a native of St. Louis MO. He graduated from Missouri State University with a BS in Public Relations and a Minor in Marketing. He completed his graduate studies at Assemblies of God Theological Seminary with a concentration in Pastoral Leadership,

Counseling and Homiletics. He entered active service as a Chaplain on 6 January 2004, at Fort Jackson South Carolina.

His military assignments include: Battalion Chaplain for 2/60th Infantry Regiment Basic Training Battalion, Fort Jackson SC; Installation Chaplain for Camps Long and Eagle, Wonju Base Cluster, Wonju Korea; Battalion Chaplain for 532nd MI BN, Camp Humphreys Korea; Battalion Chaplain for 54th Signal BN, Camp Arifjan Kuwait; Battalion Chaplain for "Fighting 5th" Combat Engineer BN, Fort Leonard Wood MO; Brigade Chaplain for 2nd Brigade Combat Team "STRIKE," 101st ABN DIV, Fort Campbell KY; III Corps Plans and Operations Chaplain, Fort Hood TX; USAG Hood, Chaplain Resource Manager, Fort Hood TX; United States Army Europe (USAREUR) Contingency Command Post (CCP)/Deputy Plans and Operations Chaplain, Wiesbaden Germany; Deputy Command Chaplain for Southern European Task Force – Africa (SETAF-AF), in Vicenza Italy; and the Chaplain Account Manager for US Army Training and Doctrine Command (TRADOC); and the Deputy Command Chaplain for TRADOC. He currently serves as the Senior Command Chaplain for the United States Army Aviation Center of Excellence, Fort Novosel AL. Chaplain Taylor has deployed three times; in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom/2010 (OIF), Operation Enduring Freedom (OEF)/2014 and Operation Inherent Resolve/2016 (OIR).

His military education includes: Chaplain Officer Basic and Advanced Course, Operational Religious Support Leaders Course, Resident Command and General Staff College, the Joint Planners Course, the Defense Strategy Course, the Army Force Management Course, the NATO Operational Chaplains Course, the U.S. Army Airborne School, the Sabalauski Air Assault School, the Chaplaincy Resource Management Course and the Combat Life Savers Course.

His awards and decorations include: the Bronze Star Medal, Meritorious Service Medal (7TH Award), Joint Service Commendation Medal, Army Commendation Medal (2OLC), Army Achievement Medal, National Defense Service Medal, Afghanistan Campaign Medal, Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary Medal (2nd Award), Global War on Terrorism Medal, NATO Medal – Afghanistan, Army Service Ribbon, Outstanding Military Volunteer Service Medal, Overseas Service Ribbon (7th Award), The Ancient Order of Martin of Tours Medal, Parachutist Badge, and the Air Assault Badge.

Chaplain Taylor has been married for 23 years to the former Denna L. Thornton, also from St Louis MO. The couple has five children: Kaelyn (20), Symone (15), Naomi (12), Lauryn (10) and KATO (Kyle Alexander Taylor II) (7).
