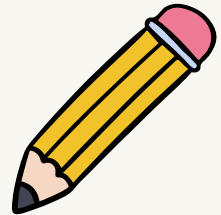

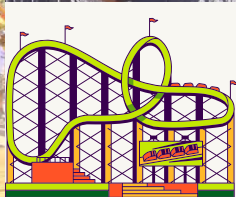
Annual Stewardess Day

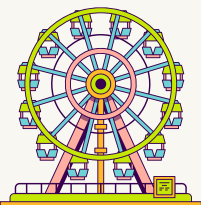

Johns Chapel has been serving these meals for over 30 years in the Methodist Side Community in partnership with Enterprise City School System.

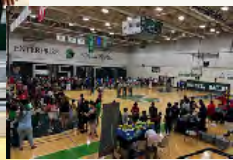
