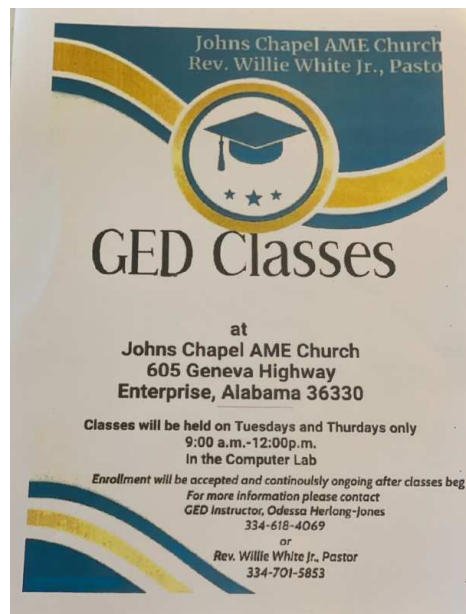

Sermon Notes

SERMON TITLE: Stronger Together

SCRIPTURE: Ecclesiastes 4:9-10 (KJV)

“Two are better than one; because they have a good reward for their labour. For if they fall, the one will lift up his fellow: but woe to him that is alone when he falleth; for he hath not another to help him up.”

POINT #1. PRODUCES. “Two are better than one; because they have a good reward for their labour. When believers join together in the work of the Lord, our efforts multiply.

POINT #2 PROVIDES. “For if they fall, the one will lift up his fellow...Life will bring moments where we stumble spiritually, emotionally, or physically

POINT #3 PROTECTS. ”...but woe to him that is alone when he falleth; for he hath not another to help him up.” The enemy loves isolation—it weakens faith and leaves us vulnerable to discouragement.
