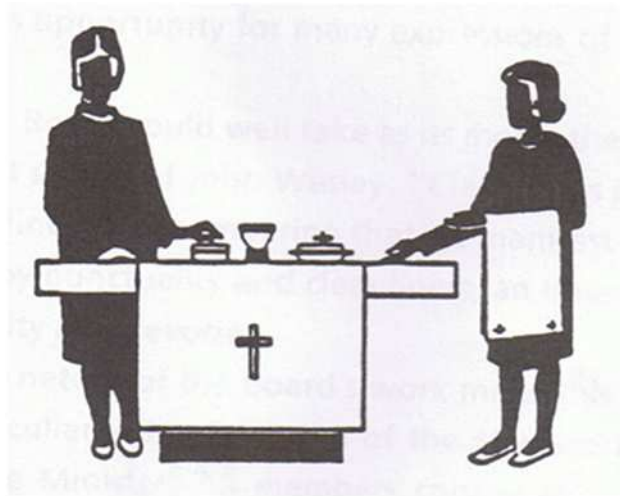

## ***Sermon Notes***

**SERMON TITLE:** “Living in the Light”

**SCRIPTURE:** 1 John 1:7 “But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin.”

**POINT #1. WALK = WALK in the Light** “But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light...”

- \* “Walk” implies lifestyle and conduct.
  - \* Walking in the light means aligning ourselves with God’s truth, holiness, and will.

**POINT #2 WITNESS = WITNESS of Fellowship**

— \* ”...we have fellowship one with another...”

\*Light not only connects us to God—it connects us to others

\*Darkness isolates; light draws us into relationship

---

**POINT #3 WASHED = WASHED by the Blood**

\*...and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanseth us from all sin.”

\* The verb “cleanseth” is present tense—it means continual cleansing.

\* The blood of Jesus doesn’t just cover sin—it removes it completely.
