

SERMON TITLE: LINK UP!!!
SCRIPTURE: 1 Corinthians 1:10
POINT #1. SPEECH Believers should communicate with words that uplift, not divide
POINT #2 SPIRIT Spiritual union strengthens the church against outside opposition.
POINT #3 STANDARDS Unity doesn't mean sameness of personality, but sameness of faith and focus.
