

### DID YOU KNOW?

Lent Season began on ASH WEDNESDAY, March 5, 2025. Lent, a period of 40 days of prayer and fasting meant to commemorate 40 days Jesus spent fasting, started on March 5 and will run until April 17 in 2025. Each year on the Friday before Easter, Good Friday is celebrated worldwide. This year, Good Friday is on April 18. This year, Easter will be celebrated on April 20. Each year, Easter is celebrated on a different Sunday, decided by the <u>first Sunday after a full moon</u> following the spring equinox, according to the old Farmer's Almanac. Pentecost Sunday is on June 8, 2025 and takes place on the 49th day after Easter Day. It commemorates the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles of Jesus while they were in Jerusalem celebrating the Feast of Weeks, as described in the Acts of the Apostles.
